

Hazardous material removal set to start at Elgin towers

Special contractors will be undertaking clean up works within the Elgin towers buildings over coming weeks.

What is happening?

- Work will start to remove hazardous materials from inside the buildings.
- Licensed contractors will be on site to remove material safely.
- Safety management plans will be in place and work will take place inside the construction fence.

What will you see and hear?

- Qualified crews will wear white safety suits and masks throughout the works.

Working hours

- Monday – Friday 7.00 am – 3.00 pm
- Saturday 8.00 am – 3.00 pm

How will we keep the community safe?

The safety of the community is our key priority.

- Access to the fenced work area will be restricted to contractors only.
- All works comply with WorkSafe Victoria and Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) Victoria regulations.

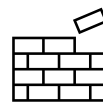

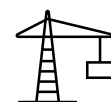
Safety scaffolding installed around each building
